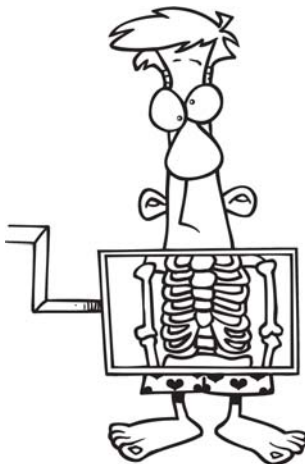

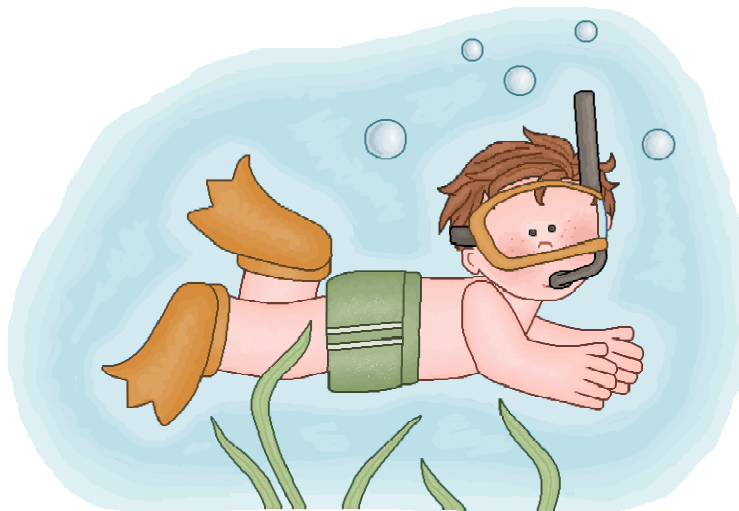

Shiny shoes and slippery socks;

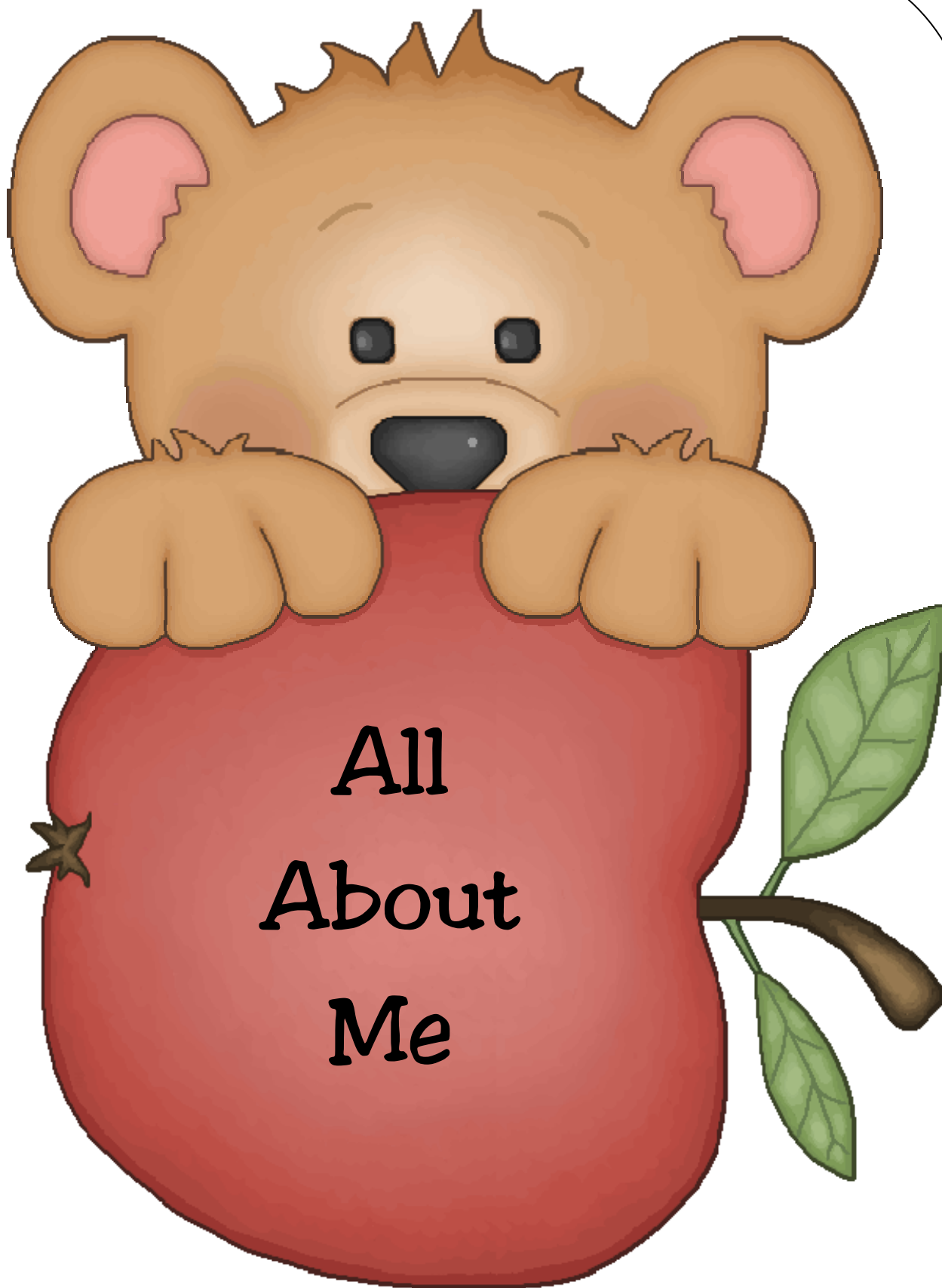
Barrettes and braids and freckled faces,
