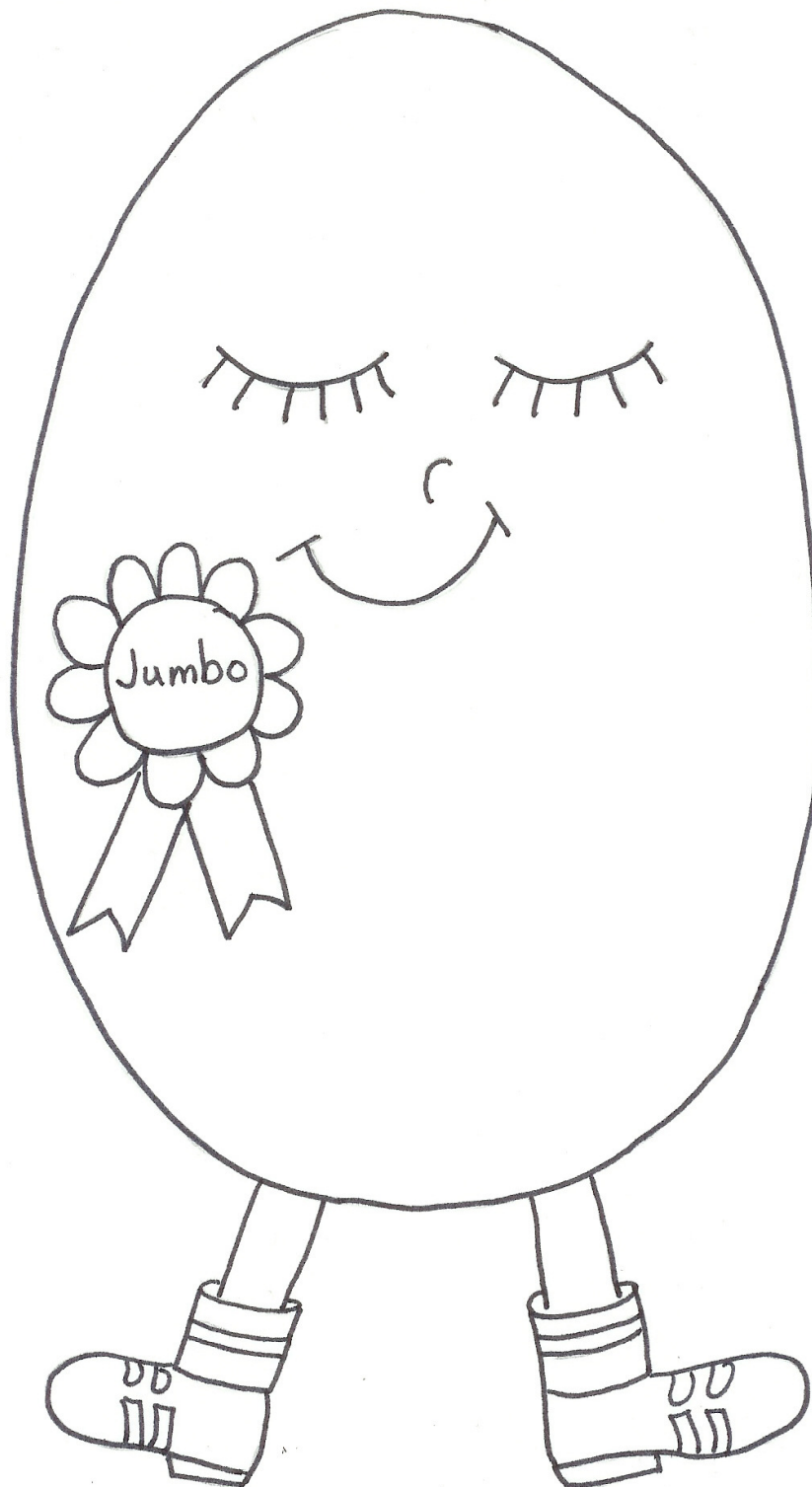
We are collected every morning.



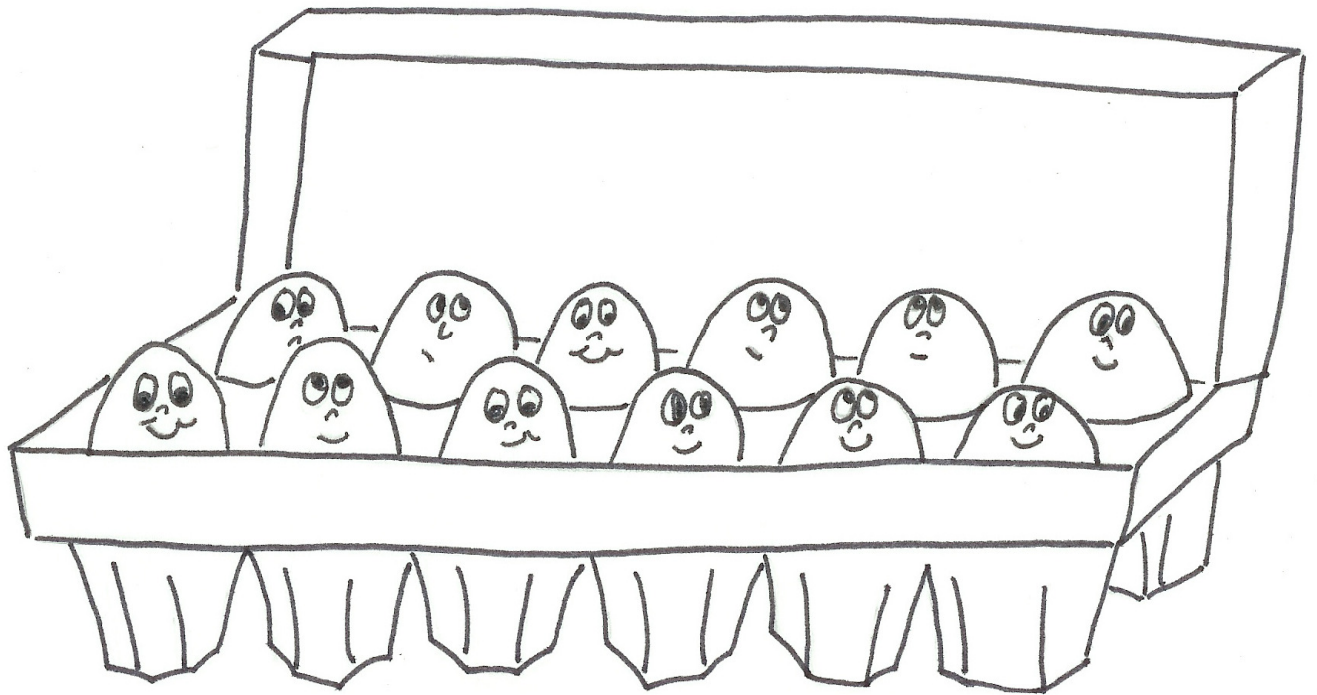
We are cleaned and scrubbed.

We are graded by size. We are jumbo, extra large, large, medium, small and peewee.



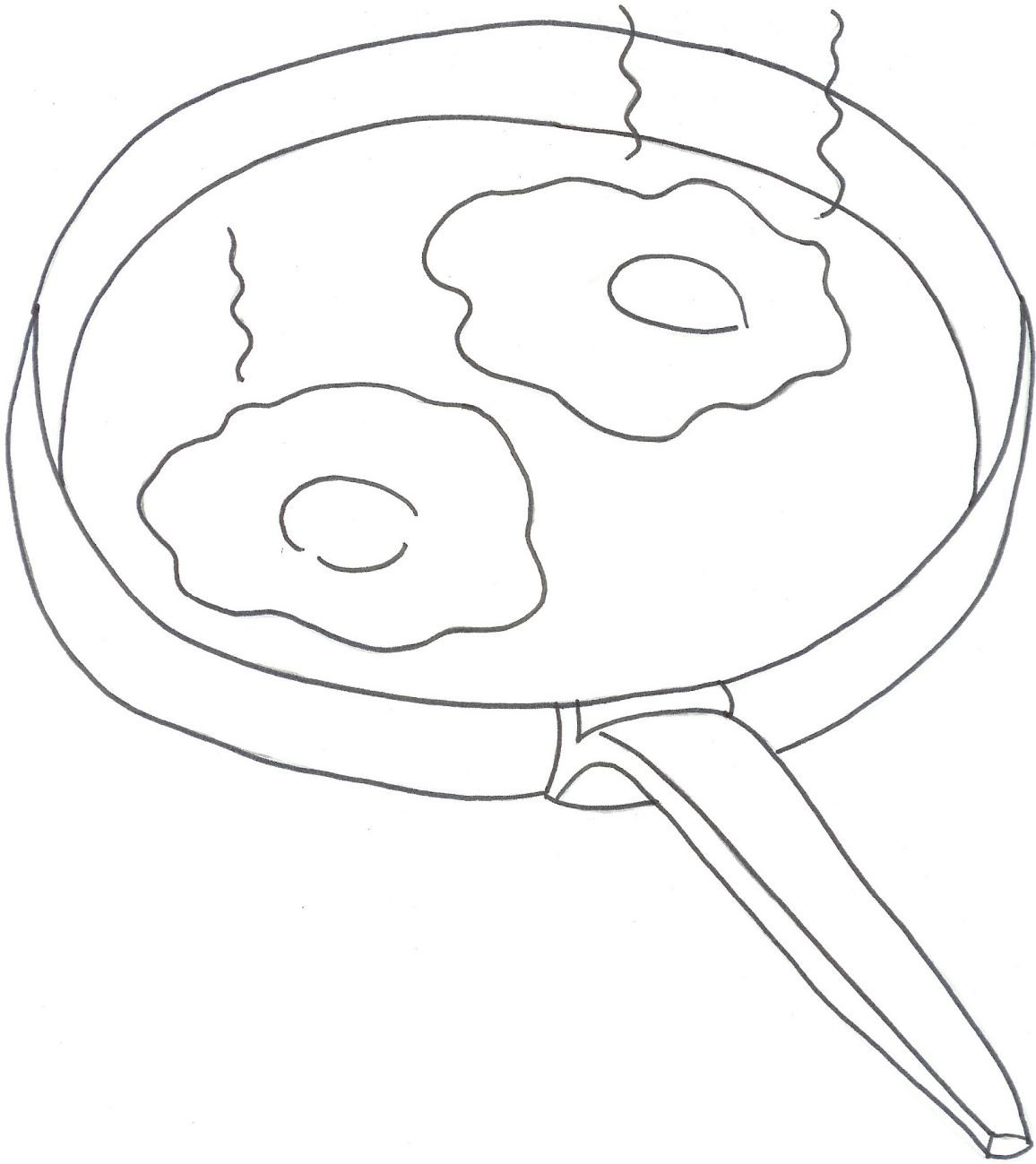
We are packed in cartons
