

Beginning Sound Picture Cards

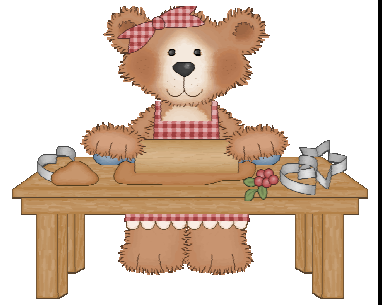

A is for apple and B is for bear . . . having anchor words and pictures facilitates the development of fluency in letter recognition, decoding and encoding. Use the following set of consonant picture/word cards with young children. Allow them to sort by beginning or ending sound, number of syllables, do an open sort, or perhaps classify them by topics or themes. Run off a second set and allow children to match words to pictures.

Please note that the initial consonants, digraphs and blends are written in red so that children become more aware of beginning sounds and spellings.
