Assembly: Print enough books for a small group. Cut out the pages, leaving an equal margin on the left side to allow for binding.

Use: Do a picture walk with the group, allowing the children to name the pictures and predict. Read through the book once, modeling correct finger pointing for 1:1 reading. Hand out copies for each child. Let them read it through on their own several times. Store books in student boxes or baskets for familiar reading.
